**D**SS Flag Day 2016 was held on Saturday, 2 April with 372 student and adult volunteers stepping forward to do their bit to fund-raise for the society.

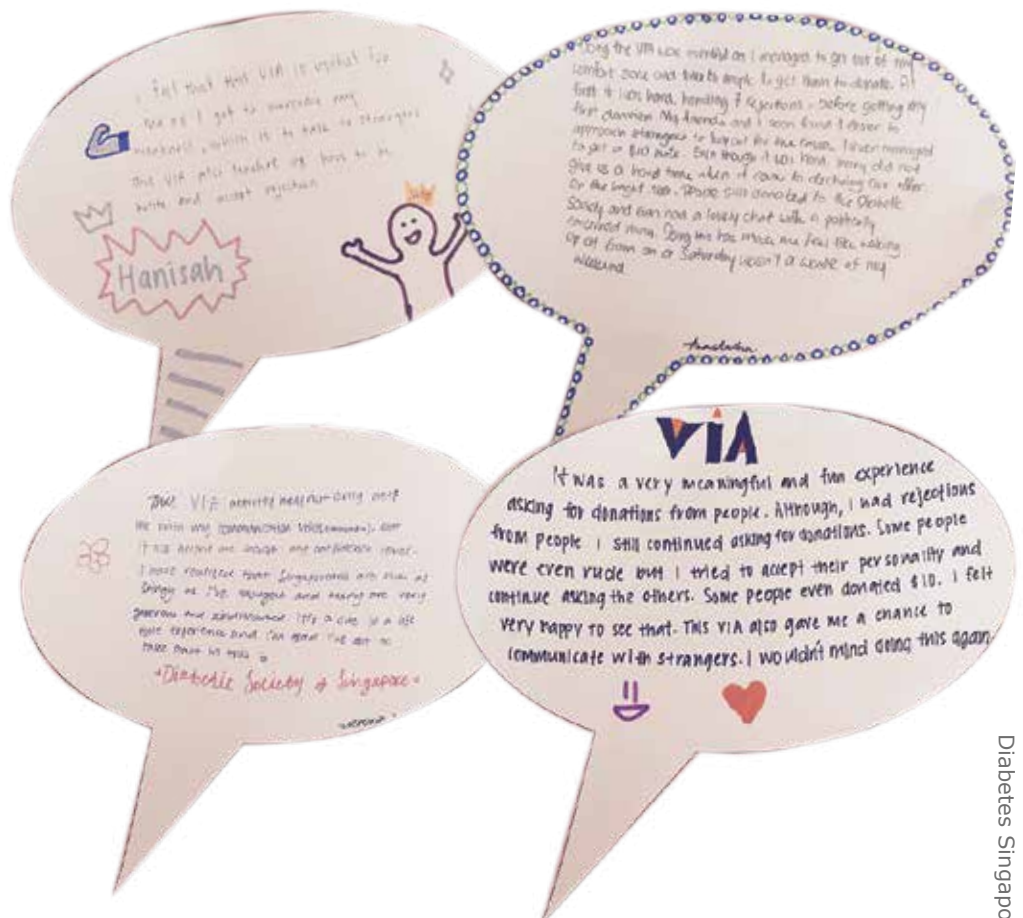
Four secondary schools participated in this year's event with Naval Base Secondary School contributing the most number of student volunteers.
